- **All instruments encouraged: Strings, Voice, Woodwinds, Piano and Keyboards**
- **Solos and Ensembles**
- **Memorization is optional**
- **Because of time restrictions, we may not be able to accept more than 3 or 4 pieces that are longer than 7 minutes. These will be on a first-come, first-served basis. If you wish to play a piece that is 7-10 minutes (maximum length allowed), please submit a second choice piece that is shorter than 7 minutes.**
- **Register, using the form below, with either the North or South Adult Performance Chair**
- **DEADLINE: (South) February 21, 2010 (North) March 1, 2010 or whenever quota has been reached (12 performer – 6 from North & 6 from South)**
- **As a courtesy to other MTAC members, it is graciously requested that teachers apply for performance every other year.**
