

**Music Teachers' Association of California
Piano Concerto Competition / Piano Solo Competition
Finalists, 1974-2007**

The Minutes of the MTAC State Executive Board, on May 10, 1973, mention that "the idea of a Piano Concerto Competition is to be presented at the Convention . . . The rules are to be firmed later." That summer, rules and regulations were established by the Board: only students of MTAC members were eligible; a complete, standard concerto was required; three age categories were established: collegiate, high school, and intermediate, with prizes of \$200, \$100, and \$50 respectively. Two regional auditions were to be held in May, 1974, one in the North, at Diablo College, and one in the South, at Los Angeles State University. Chaired by June Wilde and Mary Lou Chase, the first Concerto Competition took place with a total of 64 students participating (39 from the South and 25 from the North.)

The winners of the Northern and Southern auditions performed in a Finals on Friday, June 28, 1974, at the MTAC State Convention, held at the Sheraton Harbor Island in San Diego:

The following Fall, the Piano Technicians' Guild offered to furnish awards of \$350 to the college winner and \$200 to the high school winner of the next Concerto Competition in 1975. Also, it was decided that the teacher of a contestant may play the orchestral accompaniment at the Regional audition, but an accompanist would be provided for the Final audition at the State Convention.

According to the Minutes of October 13, 1974, "there was an informal discussion during which various suggestions regarding the requirements and rules for a Piano Solo Competition were made." The first Solo Competition took place in 1975 with two divisions: collegiate (\$200 prize) and high school (\$100). A standard work of ten minutes duration was the only requirement. A total of 32 students (13 from the North and 19 from the South) participated in the first Solo Competition.

For the 1976 competitions, the rules and regulations specified that the age limits for high school entrants would be 13 to 18 years of age and, for collegiate entries, 17 to 22 years of age. The music for the 1976 Solo Competition was limited to American-born composers (in honor of the Bicentennial), and the 1976 Concerto Competition invited participants to play either a standard concerto or an American concerto. Also, the Intermediate level of the Concerto Competition was eliminated due to expressed concerns about the ability of pre-teenagers to present a complete concerto at a high performance level.

The Piano Technicians' Guild continued their financial support of the Concerto Competition and began their sponsorship of the Solo Competition. Their generous support increased over the years, offering first and second prizes in all divisions of both competitions.

The rules of the Solo Competition have never changed. In the Concerto Competition, complete concertos were required in all divisions until 1985. In 1986, the Division I changed to a single movement. In 1990, when four divisions were created, both Divisions I and II played single movements. Since 1992, all divisions have played a single movement.

In the 1977 State Directory, Southern chair Marjorie Ziprick stated that the main objectives of the Solo and Concerto competitions are "to hear, encourage, and honor very talented, hard-working students, to plan opportunities to appear at the Convention and other places, and to attract other fine teachers to join MTAC so their students will also have these excellent opportunities."

Note: In the following pages, abbreviations are used in the first column that require explanation.

D is the Age Division in which the student was entered. From 1978 to 1989, Division I was for entrants through age 13, Division II was age 14 through 18, and Division III was age 19 through 23. Since 1990, four age divisions have been used: Division I is through age 11, Division II is age 12 through 14, Division III is age 15 through 18, Division IV is age 19 through 24.

R is the Region of California in which the student resides: N is used for Northern California and S is used for Southern California.
